Solution 1: Restart the Printer

Many temporary software issues disappear after restarting the printer.

Steps:

Turn off the printer. Disconnect the power cable. Wait 60 seconds. Reconnect the cable. Turn the printer back on. Print a test page.

Solution 2: Check Ink or Toner Levels
